Look to God, and be radiant;
so your faces shall never be ashamed.

This poor soul cried, and was heard by the LORD,
and was saved from every trouble.

The angel of the LORD encamps
around those who fear God, and delivers them.

O taste and see that the LORD is good;
blessed are those who take refuge in God. **R**

O fear the LORD, you holy ones,
for those who fear God have no want.

The young lions suffer want and hunger,
but those who seek the LORD lack no good thing.

Come, O children, listen to me;
I will teach you the fear of the LORD.

and covets many days to enjoy good?

Keep your tongue from evil,
