You are my strong sal - va - tion, Lord; Your love sur - rounds me.

- ¹ Blessed are those whose transgression is fórgiven,
whose sín is cóvered.
- ² Blessed are those whom the LÓRD does nót hóld gúilty,
and in whose spirit there is nó décéit. **R**
- ³ While I kept silence, my body wasted away
through my groaning áll dáy lóng.
- ⁴ For day and night your hand was héavy úpón me;
my strength was dried up as by the héat óf súmmer.
- ⁵ Then I acknowledged my sin to you,
and I did not hide my íníquity;
I said, "I will confess my transgressions tó thé LÓRD,"
and you forgave the guilt óf my sín. **R**
- ⁶ Therefore let all who are faithful
offer práyer tó yóu;
at a time of distress, the rush of mighty waters
sháll nót réach them.
- ⁷ You are a hiding place for me;
you preserve mé fróm tróuble;
you surround me with glad cries óf délivérance. **R**
- ⁸ I will instruct you and teach you the way yóu shóuld gó;
I will counsel you with my éye úpón you.
- ⁹ Do not be like a horse or a mule, without úndérstánding,
whose temper must be curbed with bit and bridle,
else it will nót stáy néar you.
- ¹⁰ Many are the torments óf thé wícked,
but steadfast love surrounds those who trust
in thé LÓRD.
- ¹¹ Be glad in the LÓRD and rejóice, Ó ríghteous;
shout for joy, all you úpright in héart. **R**
