The time is coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with Israel and Judah. It will not be like the covenant I made with their forefathers when I took them by the hand and led them out of Egypt. Although they broke my covenant, I was patient with them, says the Lord. I will set this is the covenant which I will make with Israel after those days, says the Lord; I will set my law within them and write it on their hearts; I will become their God and they shall become my people. Although they teach one another to know the Lord; all of them, high and low alike, shall know me, says the Lord, for I will forgive their wrongdoing and remember their sin no more.

The New Testament Scripture reading is received from **Luke** chapter **8**, verses **1-3**, which can be found on page **81** in the **new testament** of your pew bible...

After this he went journeying from town to town and village to village, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom of God. With him were the Twelve 2 and a number of women who had been set free from evil spirits and infirmities: Mary, known as Mary of Magdala, from whom seven devils had come out, 3 Joanna, the wife of Chuza a steward of Herod's, Susanna, and many others. These women provided for them out of their own resources.
