O LORD my God, you are véry gréat.
- 2 **You are clothed with honor and majesty,  
wrapped in light as wíth á gárment.**
- 3 You stretch out the heavens líke á tént,  
4 **you set the beams of your chambers ón thé wáters,**  
you make the clóuds yóur cháríot,  
5 **you ride on the wings óf thé wínd,**
- 6 you make the wínds yóur méssengers,  
7 **fire and fláme yóur mínisters. R**
- 8 You set the earth on íts fóundátions,  
so that it shall néver bé sháken.
- 9 **You cover it with the deep as wíth á gárment;  
the waters stood abóve thé móuntains.**

to the place that you appóinted fór thém.

the wild asses quénch théir thírst.

they sing amóng thé bránches.

the earth is satisfied with the fruit of yóur wórk. R**
