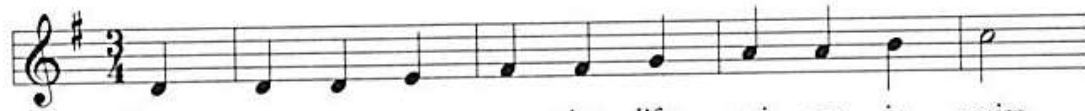


The responsive psalm is **Psalm 71:1-11**. This can be found in the **Red Psalter** in your pew. We'll be singing **Refrain I**.
