Why are you so far from helping me,  
from the words óf mý groáning?

<sup>2</sup> O my God, I cry by day, but you dó nót ánsWER;  
and by night, but fínd nó rést. **R**

<sup>3</sup> Yet you are holy,  
enthroned on the práises óf Ísrael.

<sup>4</sup> In you our ancestors trusted;  
they trusted, and you delívered thém.

<sup>5</sup> To you they cried, ánd wére sáved;  
in you they trusted, and were not pút tó sháme. **R**

<sup>6</sup> But I am a worm, not human;  
scorned by others, and despised bý thé peóple.

<sup>7</sup> All who see me mock at me;  
they make mouths at me, they shake their heads and sáy tó mé:

<sup>8</sup> “Commit your cause to the LORD;  
let the Lórd delíver —  
let the Lord rescue the one in whom the Lórd delíghts!”

<sup>9</sup> Yet it was you, who took me fróm thé wómb;  
you kept me safe on my móthér's breást.

<sup>10</sup> On you I was cast fróm mý bírth,  
and since my mother bore me you have béen  
mý Gód. **R**
