- 2 Therefore we will not fear, though the eárth shóuld  
chánge,  
though the mountains shake in the heart óf thé séa;
- 3 though its waters róar ánd fóam,  
though the mountains tremble wíth íts túmúlt. **R**
- 4 There is a river whose streams make glad the cíty óf Gód,  
the holy habitation of the Móst Hígh.
- 5 God is in the midst of the city; it shall nót bé móved;  
God will help it when the mórníng dáwns.
- 6 The nations are in an uproar, the kíngdóms tóttér;  
God's voice resounds, the éárth mélts.
- 7 The LORD of hósts ís wíth us;  
the God of Jacob ís óur réfuge. **R**
- 8 Come, behold the wórks of thé LÓRD;  
see what desolations God has brought ón thé éárth.
- 9 The Lord makes wars cease to the énd of thé eárth;  
breaks the bow, shatters the spear;  
burns the shíelds wíth fire.
