- 1 O come, let us sing to the LÓRD;
let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our
sálvátion!
- 2 Let us come into God's presence with thánksgíving;
let us make a joyful noise to the Lord with sóns of
práise!
- 3 For the LORD is a gréat Gód,
and a great Sovereign abóve áll góds;
- 4 in whose hand are the depths óf thé éarth,
and also the heights óf thé móuntains.
- 5 The sea belongs to Gód whó máde it,
and the dry land, which God's hánds háve fórméd. **R**
- 6 O come, let us worship ánd bów dówn,
let us kneel before the LÓRD, óur Máker!
- 7 For the Lord is óur Gód,
and we are the people of God's pasture,
and the sheep óf Gód's hánd. **R**
- 8 O that you would listen to the voice of the Lórd tódáy!
Do not harden your hearts, as at Meribah,
as on the day at Massah in thé wílderness,
- 9 when your ancestors téstéd mé,
and put me to the proof, though they had séen mý wórk.
- 10 For forty years I loathed that generátion ánd sáid,
"They are a people whose hearts go astray,
and they do not regárd mý wáys."
- 11 Therefore in my anger Í swóre,
"They shall not enter mý rést." **R**
